Submissions for grants can be made between October 1, 2014 – June 1, 2015. The Hamazkayin Pomegranate Film Festival Committee of Toronto will not accept applications postmarked after the deadline or the submission of incomplete applications.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION  The PomGrant program supports Directors and artists who use cinema and video as a mode of promoting Armenian culture, and provides them with opportunities for creative renewal and for production of film and video works.

ELIGIBILITY	Only Directors can apply for this grant. Applicants may work with a producer but the artist/director must maintain full creative and editorial control of the project. Eligible individuals must demonstrate creative talent, ability, need, and a lack of access to other funds in order to complement a contribution by Hamazkayin.
	<ol> <li>Applicants must be of Armenian descent or demonstrate an interest in preparing works involving Armenian subject matter.</li> <li>Proposed projects must be a film or video production.</li> <li>Proposed projects must be relevant to an Armenian theme or content and/or must promote Armenian culture and heritage.</li> <li>Every successful applicant for this grant must permit the Hamazkayin Pomegranate Film Festival Committee of Toronto the opportunity to present the project for which the funds are granted, within six months of the completion of the said project unless otherwise mutually agreed upon.</li> </ol>
